* **Hip Hop**

Ms. Jen will be teaching 4 sessions of Hip Hop this summer. There is no dance experience required for this camp, so come get funky with your friends and dance!

* **Academic Enrichment**

One on one academic enrichment with a credentialed teacher for 30 mins 4 times a week for 2 weeks. There are 4 sessions available.

* **Musical Theater**

Come experience the life of a Broadway star this summer. Our younger group will learn about healthy practices, making good choices, and fun animal facts through singing songs and dance. Our older group will learn about power harmonies as they sing popular pop ballads and read lines from iconic plays and Broadway musicals.

* **Scooter Board Hockey**

On a scooter board with a small hockey stick, kids will scoot around to get the puck in the goal. Teams will be 5 on 5, with 1 goalie, 2 defenders, and 2 forwards. The kids will learn the basic rules of scooter board hockey as they run through drills and play against each other.

• **Music Technology**

In this camp they will be learning music through enhanced music technology mediums. They will create & learn on state of the art, easy, and fun software. Some of the things they will use are hookpad, Finale notepad, and garage band.

Soccer

Swimming Lessons

Ages 5 to 12

The primary goals of the lessons are twofold; one, to help swimmers improve their technical skills, and two, to help educate and motivate swimmers to encourage their progress. Swimmers are taught in a structured and enjoyable environment that emphasizes individual improvement.

Participants will be broken into smaller groups based upon age and ability, which will allow for individualized instruction.

Dates: Session 1: June 6–17

Session 2: June 20- July 1

Session 3: July 11–22

Session 4: July 25–Aug 5

Cost: \$85 per session

30mins a day for 5 days a week

Please note that levels 2-6 will not swim on their field trip days, but the schedules on Wednesdays and Fridays are different to make up that time so your child will still receive 2 and half hours of swim lessons each week.

2016 Summer Camp Policies and Procedures

Enrollment & Fees: Summer Camp Calvine is \$185 per week. There is a \$185 deposit which is applied to the campers last week and a \$25 registration fee required to enroll. The daily rate for Camp is \$45. Attending 3 days or more constitutes a full camp week. The daily/weekly rate does NOT cover Field Trip days. There is a separate fee for campers to attend field trips . I agree to pay a late fee of \$5 per day for payments not received by 6:00 p.m. each Monday of the week my child attends and that if not paid by Wednesday my child may not continue until my account is current. Returned checks will be assessed a \$25 fee and require payment by cash/money order thereafter. I also agree to pay a \$1 late fee for every 1 minute I am late picking my child up after 6:05 p.m. I understand that in the event of repeated or serious misbehavior my child may be dismissed from camp with no refund of fees.

Refund & Deposit Policy: Fees for Camp and Specialty Classes are non-refundable, baring Camp Director approval. There will be no credit or reduction in fees granted for absences, vacations, illness, etc. for Camp or Specialty Camps.

Methods of Payment: The acceptable forms of payment for Camp are checks, credit card, or money orders made payable to Merryhill.

Registration: Campers will be registered and added to a camp bunk when the following items are received:

Summer Camp Attire: Each camper is required to wear the 2016 Summer Camp T-Shirt on their appropriate Field Trip days (Wednesdays or Fridays). Campers may wear jeans, shorts, skirts, or athletic attire during Camp. Please note that students may not wear flip-flops or open-toed shoes for safety reasons. Pool shoes may be worn to and from free swim but students will then need to put their regular shoes back on afterwards.

Summer Camp Hours: The Calvine Campus is open from 6:30 a.m.-6:00 p.m. Camp Calvine is from 9:00 a.m.-4:00 p.m. **Please see the sample daily schedule in the camp brochure for a break down of the Camp day. Camp will be closed on Monday, July 4th for the 4th of July Holiday.**

Lunch/Snacks: Lunch is only provided on Field Trip days (Wednesdays or Fridays). All other days, campers will need to bring a lunch. All campers will need to bring a morning and afternoon snack. It is recommended that campers bring a water bottle. Merryhill Calvine is a peanut-free campus.

Photographs: We reserve the right to take photographs or video of your child to be used for display or advertising purposes. Students' names will never be displayed with pictures.

Emergency Information: Each camper will need to have the registration/emergency page filled out and turned in on or prior to their first day of camp.

Personal Effects: **Electronics are not allowed during summer camp.** This includes PSP, Nintendo DS, mp3 players, cell phones, laptops etc. If campers bring any electronics they will be asked to put it away and not bring it to camp again. This also includes toys, stuffed animals, game cards, etc. If the item should appear a second time it will be confiscated and kept at the front desk for parent pickup.

Sunscreen: We ask that parents apply sunscreen to their children prior to arriving for the camp day. Should a camper need to reapply sunscreen they will need to bring their own bottle of sunscreen to camp. Campers 8 years and older will be asked to apply sunscreen with limited assistance.

Movies: Each bunk will have designated movie times throughout the week. PG rated movies (deemed appropriate) may be shown on occasion. If your camper is prone to not liking certain movies or situations, please let the staff know ahead of time.

Note to Parents: Please be open and aware when scheduling activities for your camper during the summer. Some Specialty Camps may interfere with other camp activities. **I.E.** If you sign up for a Music lesson, it may be during your campers free swim time.
