Home Enrichment

For the birds:

Easy instructions for making a bird feeder with your child to attract the fanciful creatures to your backyard:
Rinse and dry an empty, plastic milk jug.
Cut out the side opposite the handle, making sure to leave a couple of inches at the bottom so the bird seed doesn't fall out and so that the birds have a place to stand. Try for an opening about 4 inches wide.
Leave the cap on and tie a string or wire around the neck of the container.
Fill the inside with birdseed and hang it outside your window. Then grab a book on birds, and sit and enjoy the view.
