Cloud Watching

Grab a blanket, lie on your back in the back yard or in a park, and watch as the clouds float above, morphing into all kinds of interesting shapes. Feel free to get silly ("Is that a dog with an umbrella?") or contemplative ("That cloud looks like love.").
