Home Enrichment

You'll need some yarn in fall colors. Start by drawing some simple fall shapes on some box board or thin cardboard. Cut them out. We did some leaves, pumpkins, apples, and acorns. Cut little notches all the way around (it will give the yarn something to grab on to, especially around the curvier curves).

Secure the yarn to the back of your shapes with tape and wrap away! Lena did some of them all crisscross and others very neat and tidy.

This activity promotes fine motor development and is also a great sensory experience. The softness of the yarn running through your fingers feels great!
