- Demonstrates an understanding of ‘up’ & ‘down’
- Scribbles on paper using whole-arm movement

Sensory Play: Ice & Warm Water

- A container

With your toddler on the ground on a mat or towel, or with your baby in a high chair, add a piece or two of ice to a container and give it to your baby to explore. If they are tentative, you can demonstrate touching it and/or rattle it around in the container.
