Campers learn all about simple machines by engaging in hands-on activities to discover their inner workings, then using what they have learned to design and invent their own machines.



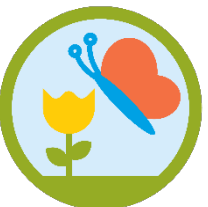
Kids Helping Kids

Forms

Please email the camp staff at lisa.goerlich@merryhillschool.com if you have any questions regarding required forms. Campers will not be permitted to attend Merryhill Midtown camp without the required forms on file. Preschool students require additional ECE licensing paperwork.

Payment

One week's tuition is due at the time of enrollment. The deposit will be applied to the final week of camp. Weekly camp fees are due every Monday. A \$25 late fee will be charged if payment is not received by 12 pm Tuesday.

Cancellation

If you enroll in camp and your plans change, or you have concerns about your child attending camp this summer, you can receive a full refund/credit for camp tuition, less registration fee. **Program change request must be received 2 weeks prior to enrolled camp week start date.** Participants who do not attend their registered camp week, or who do not contact us to cancel two weeks prior to start date, will not receive a refund or credit. By submitting your payment, you are agreeing to the policy outlined above.

Snack and Lunch

Campers will have multiple opportunities to have snacks throughout the day. Campers will not be provided snack on campus other than in the Preschool Camp program. For Kindergarten, School Age, and Extreme Camps, Hot Lunch will be offered on a limited basis from June 11th – July 31st. Campers should bring a lunch box with ice pack daily as there are no refrigeration options for our campers. The Commons and Kindergarten classrooms are equipped with microwaves for campers who need to heat up food. Please ensure that campers bring water bottles daily as Sacramento summers get hot.

2025 Camp Policies

Sunscreen

Apply sunscreen to your child prior to coming to camp and provide a hat they may wear during outside play time (please label the hat with your child's name).

On site Field Trips, Off Site Field Trips and Food Truck Friday

During the week, campers will be able to participate in on-site field trips that range from puppet shows to laser tag to game trucks. K-8th grade campers are all included in the on-site field trips unless otherwise noted in the weekly newsletter. 5th-8th grade campers will also have the opportunity attend off-site field trips at an additional cost. A list of these field trips is available on the OSCR website for more information. Each Friday afternoon, a local food truck will come to campus to provide treats to campers. These will be listed in the weekly newsletter. Alternative snacks will be provided to campers with food allergies. Please reach out to camp staff to inform us of any food allergies. Additional fees may apply for Food Truck Fridays.

Bunks and Camper Groupings (Kindergarten, School Age, and Extreme Camps only)

During every camper's time at Midtown, they will be grouped into a bunk with grade-level peers. Kindergarten will have separate bunk assignments located in the Kinder classrooms. They will check in directly to these rooms upon arrival. Other campers will check in the front hallway on our 'Bunk Board' for which bunk they are assigned. Campers will primarily stay with the same bunk throughout the summer, but if they are not attending certain weeks, they may be assigned to a different bunk when they return.

Typical Camp Day (Preschool Camp Schedule Varies)

Our campus opens at 7:30am in the summer. From 7:30-9:00am, campers are grouped by age for flexible morning activities including outside play. At 9:00am, campers will join their bunks and head off for morning activities. From 12:00-1:00pm, campers enjoy lunch and recess before moving into their afternoon activity blocks from 1:00-4:00pm. From 4:00-5:30pm, campers are grouped by age for post-camp outside play and other flexible activities until pick-up. Please note that lunch for K will run earlier than the rest of camp, from approximately 11-12pm; a daily schedule for the K programs will be provided to all enrolled families.
