THANK YOU AND REMINDERS

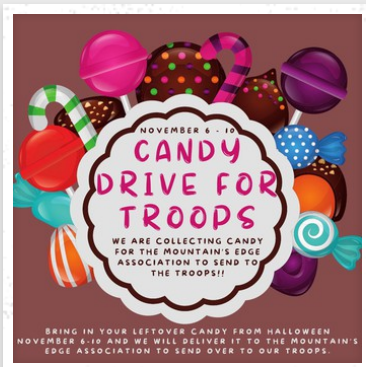
I'm sure everyone would agree that October really flew by. Thank you to all our families that donated and participated in our 3rd Annual Trunk-Or-Treat.

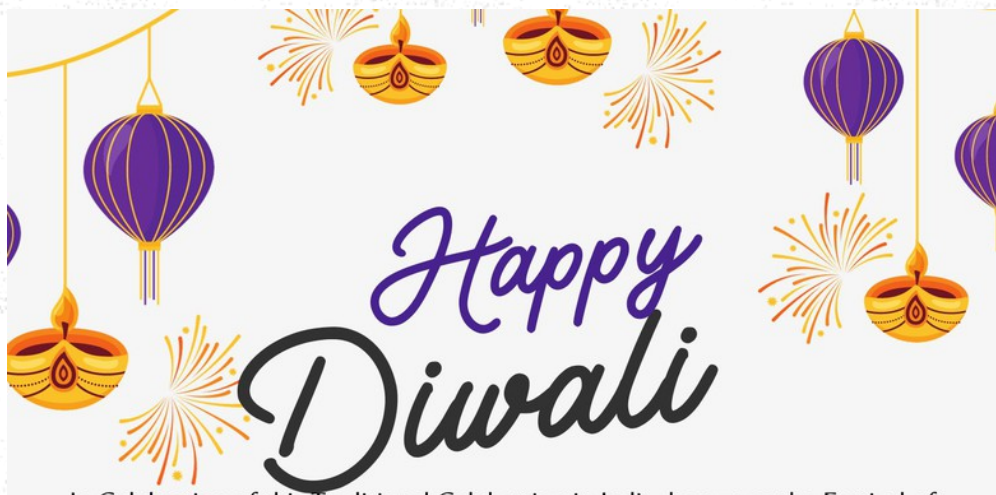
