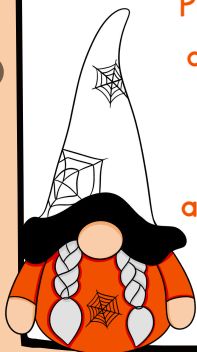


JUMPSTART'S READ FOR THE RECORD
