

Extended Day (B&A)

Our Extended Day program, also known as Before and After Care or B&A, allows busy working families the flexibility to drop off before the school day starts and pick up after the normal dismissal time. Our program is organized into several areas that are designed to provide your child with opportunities to learn valuable life skills, and to reinforce the skills they're learning during the school day, while providing plenty of time for fun with friends.

Extended Day

Our program is organized into five subject areas that are designed to provide your child with opportunities to learn valuable life skills and to reinforce the skills they're learning during the school day. Students explore the exciting world of science, technology, engineering, art and math (STEAM) through building projects, experiments, and design challenges. Sharing ideas, asking questions, and making predictions are encouraged!



Robust outdoor free play and structured games help students learn sportsmanship and develop their physical strength. Students learn critical thinking and problem solving by participating in board games and team challenges with their peers. The "Commons Lounge" is designed for students in 5th-8th grades, and consists of table top/board games, limited video games, card games, and more. While students still have the freedom to talk with friends, read, and work on homework, the "Commons Lounge" encourages increased socialization and interaction among our older students.



Students in JrK-4th grades have opportunities to express themselves by participating in hands-on visual arts, including drawing, painting, and more. Activities are designed with student age in mind, and an emphasis is placed on materials explorations.



Social and emotional growth is nurtured through student and teacher led activities that promote a feeling of community and belonging. Students learn through open-ended activities that give them a chance to apply problem-solving skills and collaborate with friends.



At Midtown, all K-8 students are provided study hall regardless of enrollment in the extended day program. During study hall, we provide students a quiet place to work on homework, read, journal, or seek academic support from peers and teachers. Students in K-5th grades have study hall from 3:00-3:45PM.





Private Music Lessons

Learn how to play the piano, violin, or ukulele! Private 1:1 music lessons are 30 minutes in length. String instruments and music books must be provided by families.
